

## THE ROBERT A. ST. PIERRE AWARD

The Duxbury Art Association grants the Robert A. St. Pierre Award annually to a high school senior who plans on further studies in the visual arts. An award of \$1,000 is given to a student who plans further study in the visual arts at an art school, college, university or through an organized program of art study; including an apprenticeship or private study with an artist. The St. Pierre Scholarship is awarded on the basis of talent, motivation and serious intent. The selection process includes:

- 1. Submission of application form, including two letters of recommendation. Presentation counts.
- 2. Student portfolio (illustrations, paintings, photographs, discs and/or slides -NO ORIGINALS, please.)
- 3. Should the committee choose you for an interview, you will be contacted by the DAA to arrange an interview.
